Description and objectives

During the past 4,5 years of CHERN's work as a COST Action, young scholars have cooperated with senior scholars supported by Short Term Scientific Mission (STSM) Grants and Virtual Mobility (VM) Grants. The outputs of these research collaborations have been disseminated primarily as blogs on the CHERN website (the two most recent examples can be found [here](#) and [here](#)), in addition to research publications. In the next phase of CHERN, we want to disseminate these results even more widely to achieve greater impact. This Virtual Mobility Grant is dedicated to planning a webinar series promoting the results of CHERN STSMs and VMs to reach a wider audience. The webinars should disseminate the key findings and insights in a format suited for the general public and be recorded and published on CHERN's YouTube channel.

Objectives:

- Identifying possible topics and speakers/panelists (min. 8)
- Designing a concrete webinar format, including webinar hosts/moderators
- Reaching out to CHERN STSM and VM grantees and hosts/moderators and creating a provisional webinar plan/schedule

NOTE: The recording of the webinars is not part of this VM grant. The schedule should start after the end of CHERN as a COST Action (mid-May 2024) and provide a realistic rhythm lasting up to one year.

Specific requirements

In addition to COST requirements (see **Practical details** below), the applicant should meet the following criteria:

- Affinity and experience with organizing events, especially online
- Interest in and understanding of CHERN related topics
- Good communication skills in English

Results

This VM will result in:

- A plan for a webinar series promoting CHERN STSMs and VMs with minimum eight webinars, including topics, provisional dates and speakers
- Report of the activities for CHERN.

Grant amount guideline: 800 euro

Deadlines

Deadline for applications to be submitted: **Accepted on a rolling basis until April 15th latest**

Notification of application outcome: **within one week**

Period of VM: Exact dates to be determined together with the host

Submitting the reports: **April 30**

Accepting/ rejecting the reports: **within two weeks** after submission of the report

Execution of the payment of the grant: **within 4 weeks** after submission of the report
